Curricular Areas

Literacy

Listening and Talking: Focus on sharing news and talking about stories.
Phonics/Spelling: Continue to learn initial sounds through Jolly Phonics and to blend sounds to make and read words.
Reading: Develop reading skills through daily reading activities with the focus on learning to read the keywords from Oxford Reading Tree and developing understanding of texts through discussion.
Handwriting: Learning to form letters correctly by participating in a variety of activities using whiteboards, painting sticks and pencils.
Big Writing: Weekly writing lessons will develop skills in imaginative and functional writing. The children will begin to write under adult's writing and then some children will begin to write independently.

Maths & Numeracy

Number, money & measure: Addition to ten with the focus on mental maths skills plus learning to write and complete addition sums.
 Measuring length and weight using non-standard units plus developing the vocabulary of measure eg. taller, tallest, heavier, heaviest etc.

Information Handling: N/A

Shape, position & movement: Patterns – making and continuing colour, shape and picture patterns.

RME: The focus will be on festivals and celebrations, such as Bonfire Night, Diwali and Christmas.

Health & Wellbeing: Focus on friendship and bullying.

Modern Languages: Developing vocabulary for hello, goodbye, My name is, plus counting and colours.

ICT skills: Using the IWB for maths and language games.

PE skills: The focus will be on developing skills in creative dance .
