Curricular Areas

Literacy

Listening and Talking: Developing skills by sharing news and discussing stories.

Phonics/Spelling: Continue to develop spelling through learning how to spell words with common patterns. Revise phonic blends through Jolly Phonics activities and games.

Reading: Develop reading skills through daily reading activities with the focus on learning to read the keywords from Oxford Reading Tree, developing expression and fluency, developing understanding of texts through discussion and developing knowledge of punctuation and its purpose in texts.

Handwriting: Learning to form capital letters correctly and to focus on neat, correctly sized letters which are in the correct position.

Big Writing: Weekly writing lessons will develop skills in imaginative and functional writing. The children will focus on story beginnings, the use of more interesting vocabulary, the use of connectives and sentences correctly punctuated.

Maths & Numeracy

Number, money & measure: Addition and subtraction to ten with the focus on mental maths skills. Then developing addition skills beyond ten with ten as an anchor eg 10+4.

Measuring length and weight using non-standard units.

Information Handling: N/A

Shape, position & movement: Patterns – making and continuing colour, shape and picture patterns.

RME: The focus will be on festivals and celebrations, such as Bonfire Night, Diwali and Christmas.

Health & Wellbeing: Focus on friendships and bullying.

Modern Languages: Developing vocabulary relating to family and pets plus revising numbers and colours.

ICT skills: Using the IWB for maths and language games.

PE skills: The main focus will be on developing skills in creative dance.
