Curricular Areas

Literacy

Listening and Talking: Contribute ideas and respect the view point of others during partner and group discussions.  
Phonics/Spelling: Jolly Phonics Spelling lists, games and dictation to practise spelling patterns.  
Reading: be able to summarise what we have read, determine what is important and ask and answer HOT questions. In our class Reading Challenge we aim to be caught reading in and out of the classroom as much as possible.  
Handwriting: revise and consolidate the use of top joins to form neat legible script.  
Big Writing: writing a newspaper report, using dialogue and creating more descriptive sentences using a variety of openers.

Maths & Numeracy

Number, money & measure: Using rounding and compensating and jumping to a tidy number to add and subtract. Link multiplication, division and fractions. Quick recall of multiplication facts. Working with money to buy and give change.  
Shape, position & movement: Shapes which tile and lines of symmetry.

Modern Languages: French: counting to 20., introducing ourselves, saying how we feel.

ICT skills: Using the internet to research and take notes.

PE skills: Using a variety of throws in order to play handball. Explore movement and techniques of creative dance from a variety of cultures.
